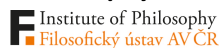


CARING DEMOCRACY: CURRENT TOPICS IN THE POLITICAL THEORY OF CARE

Karolinum (Malá Aula, 1st Floor) – Ovocný trh 3, Prague 1

Karolinum is a complex of buildings located in the Old Town. It is a national cultural monument. From the 14th century there was a residence of the oldest building of the Prague University or the Great Hall of residence (Collegium Caroli) which was founded by Charles IV for the twelve masters of the Prague University college. A unique building belongs to the Charles University since 1383 when the son of the University founder, king Wenceslas IV, obtained for the college one of the most imposing Old Town palaces which had been built shortly before by a rich patrician, a royal mint master and a banker, Johlin Rotlev (Rotlow). Since 1386, Karolinum served as a residence of the Prague professors who taught and lived here. Nowadays, Karolinum is a ceremonial assembly point of the Charles University and a residence of the rector, academic representatives and the offices.

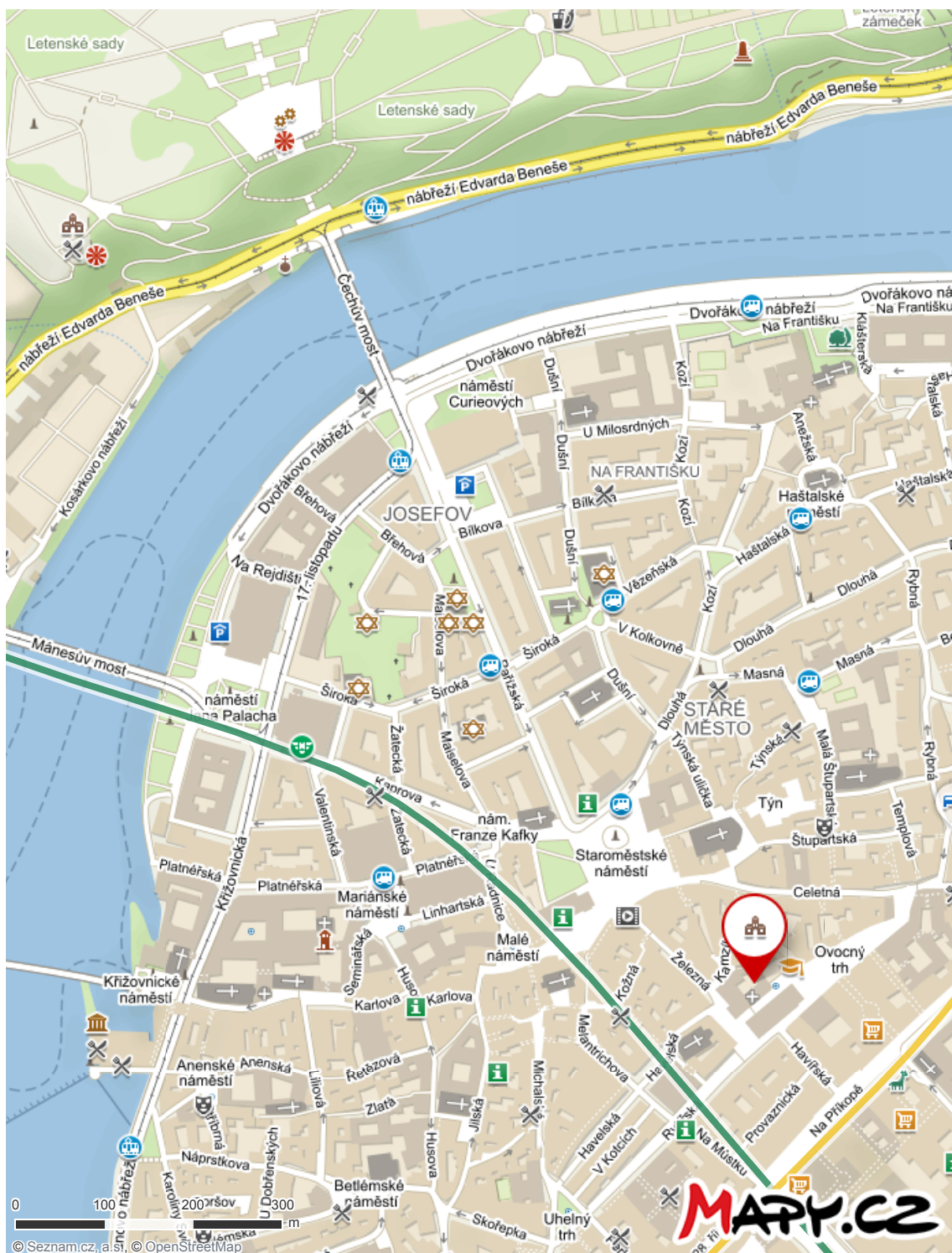
The main entrance from Ovocný trh - behind the Estates Theatre (Stavovské divadlo):

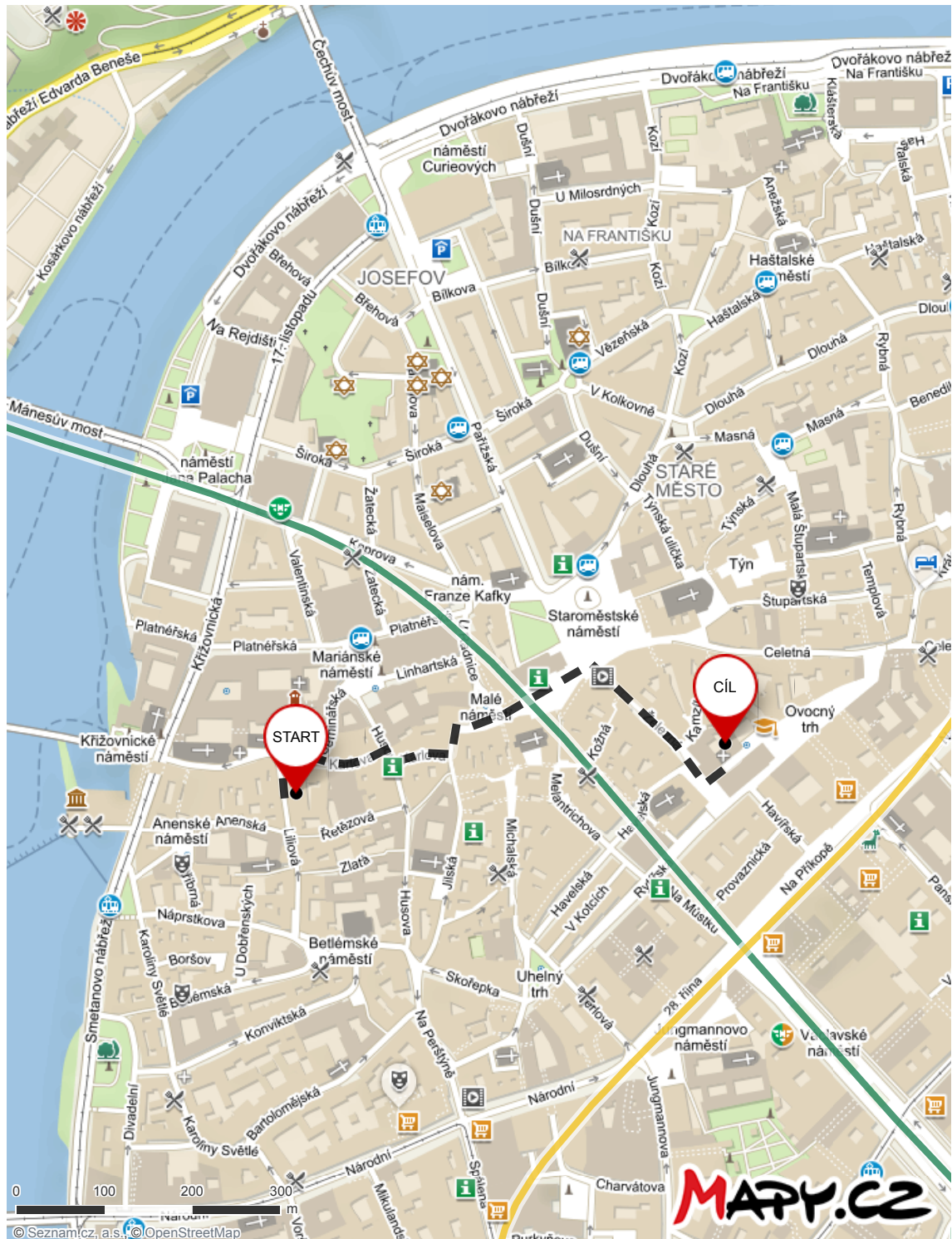
