**Format:** This course works from an interdisciplinary (philosophical, theological, nursing, clinical-ethical) perspective. During the course, national and international experts will give presentations on various topics in the domain of nursing ethics. There will be time for intensive discussions.

**Participants:** The course is of interest to participants from diverse professional backgrounds, such as nursing, medicine, philosophy and theology, health care administration, and is open to health care workers, people from universities and university colleges, members of ethics committees, and PhD students undertaking courses of study in these areas.

**Price:** The course fee will be € 820 if you register as a participant before October 15<sup>th</sup> 2019, € 920 for registration from October 15<sup>th</sup> 2019 onwards. Reduced registration fee for participants from Eastern Europe and Low Income Countries is € 620 (before October 15<sup>th</sup>) and € 720 (from October 15<sup>th</sup> onwards).
